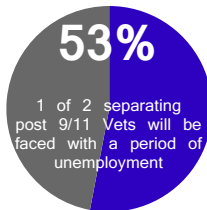

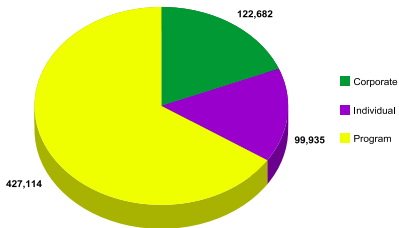

GallantFew 'guides' help transitioning Veterans stay on azimuth through local one-on-one mentoring relationships.

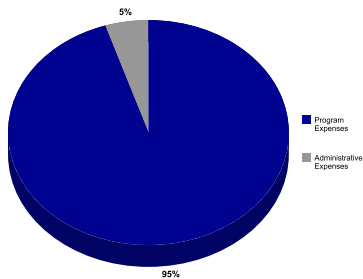

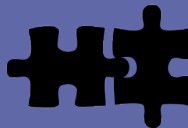
HIGH IMPACT PROJECTS
